Dear ECM Supporters and Friends,

Mark 5:25-30 ... *"she had heard the reports about Jesus and came up behind him and touched the hem of his garment... and Jesus perceived within himself that power had gone forth from him ... and he said to her: daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace and be healed of your disease..."*

Lately when sharing the Easter Story and the joy of Christ's resurrection, it seems that many people continue to be very concerned about the unrest, vicious murders and unprecedented persecutions of genuine Christians. One sometimes hears the question: Where is the Christ's garment today? Is there no hem for us to touch? Are we poorer because Jesus returned back to heaven? Praise the Lord! Our living Lord still walks in the midst of us today. Our tears and sorrows, our fevered mind and sin sick souls can still by faith touch the hem of his garment like that woman in the Gospels. The reality of Jesus Christ and the Easter message continues to go out in Estonia through Pereraadio (the Christian Family Radio network that we through ECM built there and are continuing to support), as well as via the world-wide Internet www.pereraadio.com An email we recently received in our Denver office from Pereraadio said, "Every year the Christians in Virumaa (the eastern part of Estonia) organize a convention that is broadcast through Pereraadio. During the recent convention a lady joyously got up and shared during testimony time that one year earlier she happened to listen to that certain broadcast from the convention and her life was wonderfully change by Jesus Christ who forgave all her sins, and after having been a diabetic for 25 years, was also completely healed of her illness! Praise Jesus!

Our Estonian Children's work continues to grow as the reports from the Christmas vacation seminars, children's and junior camp reports indicate. Many kindergarten kids also heard the true meaning of Christmas presented in public schools. The Lego-project was able to buy quite a number of Legos from Denmark with the money we sent from Denver through your giving. Thank you! One boy named Ervin is so enthusiastic about building "a strong (lego) church" and is figuring out how substantial the pillars and rafters need to be. He is bringing other boys to the lego-meetings and through this, his own faith is growing. Let's keep praying for this fantastic project of building young lives on Christ, the cornerstone! Pray also for one of the workers as she will be sharing the true Easter Story on this Monday, March 21st in a kindergarten in Tallinn. The doors are wide open: pray for more dedicated workers!

On the 24th of February the nation of Estonia celebrated its 98th (original) Independence Day. 54 years ago on the Independence Day, I (Endel) with the backing of the "Estonian Church at Home" Radio Board, was called by God to launch for the very first time a brand new half hour radio program, "Kodukirik," via Radio


KARI 550 AM from the U.S. border town of Blaine, reaching Northwestern Washington State and beaming into Vancouver, BC to reach the Estonian refugee population for Christ. This year, after much prayerful consideration and consultation with the radio board, on the last Sunday in February I preached my last farewell Independence Day message on that particular program concluding with a salvation message of physical and spiritual freedom. Every Sunday afternoon throughout these past 54 years, the resurrection message of Christ, along with music, has been going out through this broadcast, and only eternity will reveal the final results. Many, many listeners have gone to be with the Lord, and a new generation, many of which have married locals, have gone to American and Canadian churches or no longer speak the Estonian language – so the need for such a program is no longer as vital and is costly. The younger generation use the Internet and can get direct radio programming from Pereraadio in Estonia. We praise and thank God and the many co-workers through whom He has made it possible by His evident approval and blessings throughout these years. All glory belongs to Him!

Our special prayer request is that God continues to bless your faithful financial support of the rest of the ongoing ECM ministry. As you may know, as a result of God's special calling, Endel, like the apostle Paul, has been blessed in many unusual ways in his unique ministry, but also like the apostle Paul, (2 Cor. 11), for some time has also faced untold satanic attacks (no shipwrecks as yet), which seals the successful fulfilling of God's call on his life. PTL! As we shared in our last News/Prayer Letter, Endel was diagnosed with congestive heart failure. In February he had a pacemaker installed and receives additional oxygen most nights. He trusts God and looks forward to being called Home whenever "that time" comes. Meanwhile we rejoice and feel that God's peoples' prayers are being answered and are lifting us up and giving us new strength each day.

We are most grateful for your continued prayers. The Lord willing, soon after our next Board Meeting we expect to share more of God's plan for Estonian Christian Ministries.

May the joy of the Lord and the power of His resurrection fill our hearts this Easter Season and may God favor you with His many blessings during this beautiful springtime of the year!
